Highlights:

"Housekeeping is a support service department in a hospital, which is responsible for cleanliness, maintenance & aesthetic upkeep of patient care areas, public areas and staff areas". Housekeeping services in a hospital is entrusted with maintaining a hygienic and clean hospital environment conducive to patient care & services comprising of the activities related to cleanliness, maintenance of hospital environment and good sanitation services for keeping premises free from pollution. Housekeeper literally means "keeper of the house". Hospital housekeeping management may be defined as that branch of general management dealing with cleanliness of the hospital, general environmental hygiene, sanitation and disposal of waste using appropriate methods, equipment and manpower.

Objectives of Housekeeping Department: -

- To attain and maintain high standards of cleanliness and general upkeep.
- To train, control and supervise staff under its establishment.
- To ensure safety and security of all staff under its department and to keep superior authorities informed about day-to-day activities.
- Control and issue of cleaning materials and equipment.
- To maintain official records on staffing, cleaning materials and equipment.

Duties: -

- Toilet/corridor/surroundings/roof top/celling cleaning and disinfection spray.
- Wipe-out blood and other body fluids and then disinfect the area of contact.
- Check water logging/mosquito breeding/plastic waste littering/weed growth.
