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## INTRODUCTION

### 1.1 AIIMS, KALYANI

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Kalyani was established by an Act of Parliament as an autonomous institution of national importance Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana [PMSSY] similar to AIIMS New Delhi. By virtue of this Act, the Institute awards its own medical degrees, diplomas and other academic distinctions. The degrees awarded by the Institute under the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Act are recognized Nursing qualifications by the Indian Nursing Council are deemed to be included in the first schedule of that Act, entitling the holders to the same privileges as those attached to the equivalent awards from other universities of India. The nursing college started its first academic session on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2022 with its first batch of nursing students with an uptake of 60 students. The admission process is being conducted through the common National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (Undergraduate) For NURSING by the National Testing Agency (NTA).

The Institute (AIIMS, Kalyani) is a residential University in which the faculty members, staff and the students live on campus. There are hostels for undergraduate and nursing students inside the campus.

## AIMS & OBJECTIVES

### 2.1 MISSION

Main mission is to establish a centre of excellence in nursing education, training, health care and research imbued with scientific culture, compassion for the sick and commitment to serve the underserved.

### 2.2 AIMS

Correcting regional imbalances in the availability of affordable and reliable tertiary healthcare services and also to augment facilities for quality nursing education creating a critical mass of nurses and conduct research in the country relevant to the area.

### 2.3 OBJECTIVES

- To develop a pattern of teaching in undergraduate and postgraduate nursing education in all its branches so as to demonstrate a high standard of nursing education to all nursing colleges and other allied institutions in India.
- To bring together in one place educational facilities of the highest order for the training of the personnel in all important branch of the health activity.
- To attain self – sufficiency in post graduate nursing education.



### DURATION OF COURSE

The Course of studies leading to the award of B.SC (Hons) Nursing at of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Kalyani shall last for a minimum of **four years including 6 months integrated internship**.

### RESERVATION OF SEATS

#### 5.1 RESERVATION OF SEATS AT AIIMS, KALYANI IS AS FOLLOWS:

Other Backward Class: 27%  
Schedule caste: 15%

Scheduled Tribe: 7.5%  
Economically weaker section: 10%

- If requisite number of suitable candidates is not available to fill up the seats reserved for the Scheduled Castes, the same will be filled by candidates belonging to the Scheduled Tribes and vice-versa.
- In case suitable candidates are not available from the two reserved categories, the vacant seats will be filled up by the candidates from the general category.
- In case suitable candidates are also not available in the OBC (NCL)/EWS reserved category, the same will be filled up by the candidates from the general category.
- For Indian Nationals, 5% reservation for Person with Benchmark Disability shall be provided on horizontal basis, in the seats advertised.

#### 5.2 CRITERIA FOR OTHER BACKWARD CLASSES (NON-CREAMY LAYER) [OBC-NCL]:

Reservation for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) shall be according to the rules of the Government of India. Applicants are required to ensure that he/she does not belong to the persons/sections (Creamy Layer) mentioned in Column 3 of the Schedule to the Government of India, Department of Personnel & Training O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/93 which is modified vide OM No. 36033/3/2004 Estt. (Res.) dated 09/03/2004 or the latest notification of the Government of India (i.e. Central list). A format is provided at the end of the Prospectus. Certificate to be produced during Seat Allocation.

### **5.3 CRITERIA FOR SCHEDULED CASTE / SCHEDULED TRIBE (SC /ST)**

Reservation for SC/ST candidates will be according to the rules of Government of India. Applicants will be required to produce the necessary certificate in the format provided. During Seat Allocation the certificate as prescribed in M.H.A., O.M., No. 42/21/49-N.G.S. dated the 28.1.1952, as revised in Dept. of Per-& A.R. letter No. 36012/6/76-Est. (SCT), dated the 29.10.1977, to be produced by candidate belonging to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe in support of her claim.

### **5.4 CRITERIA FOR PERSONS WITH BENCHMARK DISABILITY (PWBD)**

In accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, 5% seats of the annual sanctioned intake capacity shall be filled up by candidates with benchmark disabilities, based on the merit list of AIIMS B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing Entrance Examination. For this purpose, the Specified Disability contained in the Schedule to the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. The candidate must possess a valid document certifying his/her physical disability. The disability certificate should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions. All PWBD candidates shall be evaluated by a Medical Board of the Institute to determine eligibility.

### **5.5 CRITERIA FOR ECONOMICALLY WEAKER SECTION [EWS]**

Reservation for EWS shall be according to the rules of the Government of India. Applicants will be required to produce the necessary certificate in the format provided at the end of the prospectus in support of his/her claim. EWS certificate is valid only if issued on the basis of income from all sources for the current financial year.

**6.1 GENERAL**

AIIMS Kalyani has a B.Sc. (Hons) Nursing course divided into 4 years with 6 months integrated internship. The overarching goal is to cover the basics of all aspects of internship Nursing. Admitted candidates must **attend the Orientation Programme** and join classes on the stipulated date. The admission of the candidates, who fail to join the Course by the date stipulated in the letter of intimation, shall automatically be cancelled and such seats shall then be offered to the candidates on the waiting list in order of merit in the same category.

**A candidate is eligible to appear in Entrance Examination if he/she:**

- i. is an Indian citizen
- ii. has attained or will attain the age of 17 (seventeen) years as on the 31st of December of the year of admission.
- iii. has passed the 12th class under the 10+2 scheme/Senior School Certificate Examination or Intermediate Science or an equivalent examination from a recognized University/ Board of any Indian State with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- iv. has a minimum aggregate mark required in qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 or equivalent:  
**55% for Gen/OBC (NCL)/EWS (50% in case of SCs/STs categories) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.**

**Note1. For B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing course, only female candidates are eligible.**

**Note2.**

- a) Candidates who are to appear in 12th class examination under 10+2 system or an equivalent examination in March/April of current year and whose results are likely to be declared before 30th June, of current year are also eligible to apply for B.Sc. (Hons.) Nursing Course.
- b) Candidates who are due to appear at the qualifying examination, or have already appeared and are awaiting result can also apply for admission. But such candidates must furnish proof of passing the qualifying examination with requisite percentage of marks and subjects at the time of Seat allocation failing which their candidature will be cancelled.

**Those candidates who joined any B. Sc. course his/her Original certificates will be retained and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course. If a candidate who joined the B. Sc. (Hons.) Nursing, leaves the said course in between, shall be liable to pay a sum of Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) by way of compensation/losses incurred by the AIIMS due to such midstream departure.**

The cut off in qualifying marks for admission is required in entrance test for all BSc courses shall be **50% for UR/EWS, 45% for OBC and 40% for SC and ST.**

Candidates selected for admission to the **B.Sc. (Hons) Nursing** course at the AIIMS Kalyani after verification of their eligibility and offered admission should bring the following original certificates/ testimonials/documents along with one set of self-attested copies at the time of verification:

1. Registration slip provided by AIIMS, New Delhi
2. Admit card issued by AIIMS, New Delhi
3. Offer letter issued by AIIMS, New Delhi
4. Seat allocation letter issued by AIIMS, New Delhi
5. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing her date of birth.
6. Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examinations, showing the subject offered by him/her in the Examination
7. Certificate/Mark sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case of SC/ST/Persons with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
8. Migration Certificate from the University/Board last attended by him/her.
9. 'No objection Certificate' if the candidate is already employed with Central / State Government / Public Undertaking.
10. Applicable only to candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/OPH Category:
  - a. SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
  - b. OBC Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the **central list** of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy layer. OBC certificate must be in the prescribed format.
  - c. Certificate from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Disability Category.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of his/her caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.7.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.



### 6.3 ATTENDANCE

A minimum attendance for passing the **B.sc (Hons) Nursing** course is mandatory.

A candidate must have minimum 80% attendance in theory and 80% in practical (irrespective of the kind of absence) for appearing in examination. However, in extreme circumstances beyond the control of the candidate 5% waive off of attendance may be done by the Dean Academics. A candidate must have 100% attendance in each of the practical areas before award of Degree.

**Any student with attendance less than the above norms will NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE final Examination.**

### 6.4 ATTEMPTS

1. Students would only be permitted to take final examinations if they get at least 50% marks in each subject in internal announcement.
2. If a candidate fails in the subject (either theory or practical) has to appear in the examination for both theory and practical paper of that subject.
3. If a candidate fails in any subject, maximum three attempts (including first attempt) are permitted for each subject.
4. A candidate, who fails in up to two papers, shall be admitted provisionally in the next year, but she has to clear those papers in next two subsequent examinations. If the candidate taking supplementary examination along with next year examination her result of next class will be declared only if she passes previous examination. Incase if she fails to clear supplementary examination in two subsequent attempts she would deemed to have failed.
5. If any candidate who could not pass all the subjects in 3 chances, including the regular chance, their result shall be declared as failed and she has to appear in all the subjects of that year in the subsequent annul examination
6. A candidate failing in more than two subjects will not be promoted to the next year and she has to appear in all the subjects of that year in subsequent annul examination without attending the regular course of instruction. However, if candidate wish re-attend the course of instruction of that year; she may avail this opportunity by paying the prescribed fee of that year. Furthermore, candidate may have a provision to improve the internal assessment marks of that year.
7. The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed eight years.



## 6.5 WEIGHTAGE FOR INTERNAL MARK

Twenty-five percent of marks in the summative examination would be calculated from the daily evaluation and end semester examination marks.

A Candidate has to pass in and practical exams separately in internal assessment.

## 6.6 COMPULSORY INTERNSHIP TRAINING

- i. Six months compulsory internship starts after theory and practical training in five subjects of the fourth year of the course.
- ii. During internships students will be posted in all three shift duties and assume all the responsibilities of patient care in assigned area under the supervision of teacher/ faculty of the Department of Nursing/ College of Nursing.
- iii. Internship / Integrated practice is 8 hours of clinical duties per day.
- iv. Calculation of hours during internship to be done as 8 hours per day @ 48 hours per week.
- v. **Fourth year final examination to be held only after completing internship.**

**7.1 SUPREME COURT RULES REGARDING ANTI RAGGING**

As per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside the campus and all the AIIMS authorities are determined not to allow any form of ragging. Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or instigates ragging within or outside any of the AIIMS shall have an FIR lodged against him/her and he/she will be suspended or rusticated from the institution and shall also be liable to be fined which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later that he/she has indulged in ragging, admission can be refused or he/she shall be expelled from the educational institution. The punishment may also include, suspension from attending the classes, withholding/ withdrawing fellowship/ scholarship and other financial benefits or withholding the result.

**7.2 ANTI RAGGING REGISTRATION**
